On May 9th, 2008 Illinois joined New York to become the second state to mandate green cleaning in elementary and secondary schools. Under authorization granted by passage of the Illinois Schools Green Cleaning Act the state has set forth a series of required and recommended “best practices” to improve the health and environment of elementary and secondary schools in Illinois.

The Schools of Illinois Public Cooperative (SIPC) was founded with the technical assistance of Southern Illinois University and provides school districts, community colleges, and universities an opportunity to achieve green cleaning certification.

The gathering is being hosted by the SIPC to recognize district members that have achieved green cleaning certification through SCORE and as an opportunity to expand the conversation on sustainability for education facilities in the hopes that human health and the environment ultimately will benefit from this exchange of ideas.
